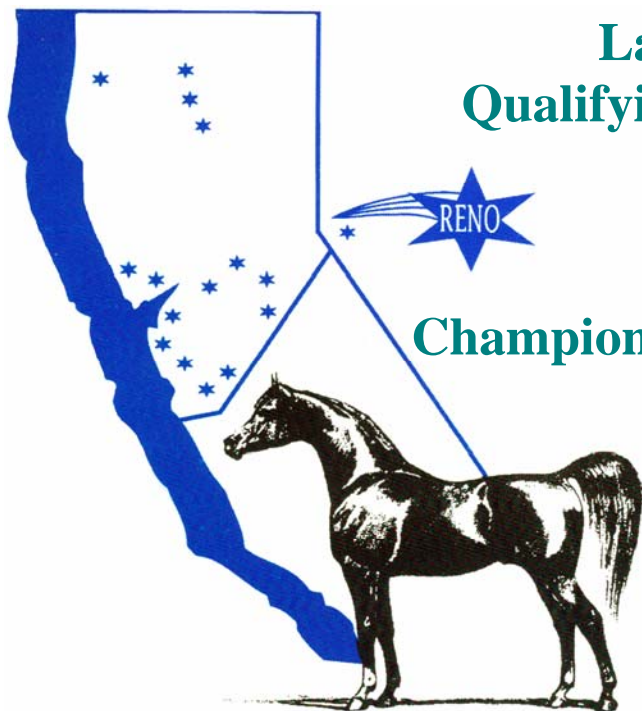

REGION III QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

Horses must be issued a Certificate of Registration from the Arabian Horse Association, the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or the Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar and OWNED BY A MEMBER OF THE ARABIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION. Horses must be qualified in an AHA Recognized show/division that was held within the preceding calendar year and that period of the current year to the final deadline of entries of the show in which the Regional Championship is held.

Horses must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division held within Region III area for the Regional Championship class(s) to be entered. All horses entering any Regional Amateur Owner (AO, AAO, JO and Select AO, AAO, JO) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur Owner. It is the responsibility of the Amateur Owner to abide by this rule. All horses entering any Regional Amateur (ATR, AATR, JTR or Select JTR) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur. It is the responsibility of the Amateur to abide by this rule.

REGIONAL QUALIFICATION RULES

See AHA Handbook Chapter 11, 12 & 13. The points/score listed on the National Class List for Regional classes must be obtained in the same AHA Section listed in the AHA Standard Class List. The Point System as reflected on the National Class List is implemented for all Regional classes. The number of points a horse receives is based on the number of horses shown and judged. Horses will earn one point for every horse in the class. (Refer to AHA 1240). Regional Top Five, Champion or Reserve Champion does not qualify a horse for a Regional Championship Class. Points, scores or **placing** from shows other than Regional shows will count for Regional shows. Points for qualifications will be awarded to horses placing first thru sixth only. **In addition to points, Regional Shows allow qualifications by earning one first place ribbon or one second place ribbon (BOD 8/09)**

TRAIL USING SCORES – Horse must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Trail horses MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

WORKING COW USING SCORES – Horse must be qualified at an AHA or NRCHA Recognized show/division for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Working cow MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

REINING USING SCORES – Horse must be qualified at an AHA Recognized show/division or NRHA Sanctioned Class for the Regional Championship class(s) entered. Reining horses MAY use ONE score of 68 or better to qualify or one point.

AWARDS - A Champion and Reserve Champion plus three additional unranked awards shall be made in each Regional Class to make a Top Five. Region III Championship Show will give a **FULL TOP FIVE** awards to each class regardless of how many entries are competing at the close of the gate. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award and Distance Award Points.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES -- Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes Allocated "Category A" and Category "B" Points payback Sweepstakes prize money is available at each 2011 Regional Championship Horse Show. Horses must be properly entered in the Sweepstakes program at the time of competing in said class. See additional information in this premium book.

SWEEPSTAKES PAYBACK CLASSES – Breeders Sweepstakes Category "B" Classes are designated with an asterisk (**). Classes are open to ALL horses. Sweepstakes Points Payback prize money is available at every AHA recognized event. Only horses properly enrolled in the Sweepstakes Points Program directly through AHA at a yearly one time fee of \$100.00 per horse made prior to the horse being shown for the points, will count for points payback at the end of the year. Show secretaries can not accept nominations. Horses must be nominated directly through AHA only. See additional information in this premium book.

VERIFICATION OF QUALIFICATION FORM - The qualification information (show, date, class title, placing, points and/or score) must be listed on the **VERIFICATION QUALIFICATION FORM** for each horse and all classes entered in the Region III Championship Show. **THE COMPLETED FORM MUST BE SENT TO THE SHOW SECRETARY ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM.** An **INCOMPLETE FEE** will be assessed if the Qualification Verification Form is not sent along with entry form. The Qualification Verification Form can be found on **Page 22** of this premium book.

Main arena is OPEN for schooling horses (NO LONGEING) as listed below:

Sunday July 10th to Saturday July 16th 5:00 to 7:00 a.m. (except Wed a.m. closed)

Sunday, Monday, Friday - AFTER last class (until 12:00 midnight)

Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday - AFTER last class (approx. 6:30 p.m. until 12:00 p.m.)

Lunch and Dinner Breaks - IF time allows

CENTER RING

No one is allowed in the center ring except judges, officials and staff. When arena is open for schooling of horses, the center ring area (including tables, couches, chairs, etc) is closed to all exhibitors, trainers, friends and family.

CANCELLATION

To encourage early entries, the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date (June 1st).

CLASS CONFLICTS

EXHIBITORS ARE CAUTIONED AGAINST ENTERING THE SAME HORSE IN SUCCESSIVE CLASSES OR TWO RINGS AT SAME TIME. DUE TO FULL SCHEDULES, GATES WILL NOT BE HELD FOR RIDERS WITH CONFLICTING SCHEDULES IN TWO RINGS. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR RING CONFLICTS OR CLASS CONFLICTS. PLAN YOUR CLASS SCHEDULE VERY CAREFULLY.

HOSPITALITY

Coffee, tea, hot chocolate and doughnuts will be available at the Region III Hospitality Booth located in BARN 9 daily from 6:30 AM to 8:00 AM throughout the show, compliments of Region III.

REFUNDS

Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Refunds of entry fees will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate accompanied with a letter explaining the circumstances to the Show Secretary, PRIOR to the start of said show. Requests for any refunds due to the illness or injury of the exhibitor MUST be in writing, accompanied by a Veterinarian certificate or Doctors letter, and MUST be received by the show secretary PRIOR to the start of the said show. On approved refund requests, ONLY class fees will be refunded with 25% of class fees retained for processing. NO refunds will be made on drug fees, resolution fees or office fees. Refunds on stall or tack room fees will NOT be made after June 19TH. All refunds granted will be made by mail in approximately 3 weeks.

STABLING INFORMATION

Stalls are available for the **ONE TIME FEE of \$135.00 PER STALL** for the duration of the show (July 7th - July 17th). Stalls can only be assigned to horses entered and all other will be considered tack or groom rooms. **STALLS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE UNTIL THURSDAY, JULY 7th 6:00 a.m. and MUST be vacated by Sunday JULY 17th by 5:00 p.m.** Due to the size of the show & the scheduling of classes, it is necessary to have a **ONE TIME FEE of \$135.00 per stall regardless of your arrival or departure dates.** *Due to the time necessary to prepare the facilities between events at RLEC, horses may **NOT** be stalled on the grounds until THURSDAY JULY 7th. Any special considerations **MUST** be arranged with the Show Secretary. There will be an additional daily fee per stall for any exceptions to dates listed. Anyone arriving before July 7th (6:00 a.m.) or departing after July 17 (5:00 p.m.) will be required to pay an additional fee and **MUST** make special arrangement with show secretary or barn manager. Tack and Grooming Room are available at the **ONE TIME FEE of \$135.00 per Room** for the duration of the show. Tack/grooming rooms will **NOT** receive bedding. Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals). Horses must be placed in the stalls assigned. No changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. All stalls have full doors and will include two bags of SHAVINGS.

IMPORTANT – If you are showing a horse in the Silver Sire Futurity Show ONLY on Thursday that is not entered in the Region III shows and you want a stall with your other Region III horses, be sure to order the stall on the Region III Entry form. All stalls must be reserved & paid through Region III Show for Silver Sire Futurity Show.

ASSIGNMENT OF STALLS

EXHIBITORS WISHING TO BE STABLED TOGETHER MUST SUBMIT THEIR ENTRIES IN THE SAME ENVELOPE. Assignment of stalls will be made as fairly as possible on the basis of many considerations, including show support, time of receipt of entries, number of horses, show decor, ring use, etc. We ask your cooperation in these assignments. If you have special requests or considerations, please submit them with your entry. All requests will be considered but no promises can be made. **BE ADVISED:** Regarding horses that are entered after June 1st or post entered late and request stabling with other horses previously entered, original stalling assignments WILL NOT be changed to accommodate the late entry. Management will try to stable late entries **AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE** to other entries but **NO GUARANTEES** can be made. Show management's decision is final.

TYPES OF STALLS AVAILABLE

Refer to Barn Map for location of stalls available. Information on **STABLE WITH LINE** on the entry form will be considered but **NO GUARANTEES** can be made.

PERMANENT STALLS -- Barns No. 7-24

440 PERMANENT 10 X 12 metal stalls are available. These stalls have stall mats. Electric outlets and water outlets are located at convenient locations in each aisle. Wash racks with warm water are located close by. Aisle ways are asphalt. Absolutely no nail/screw holes or marks of any type are allowed in or on the walls of these stalls. Any exhibitor found in violation of this RULE will be charged accordingly for repair and repainting.

BIG BARN 1 – CONVERTIBLE STALLS

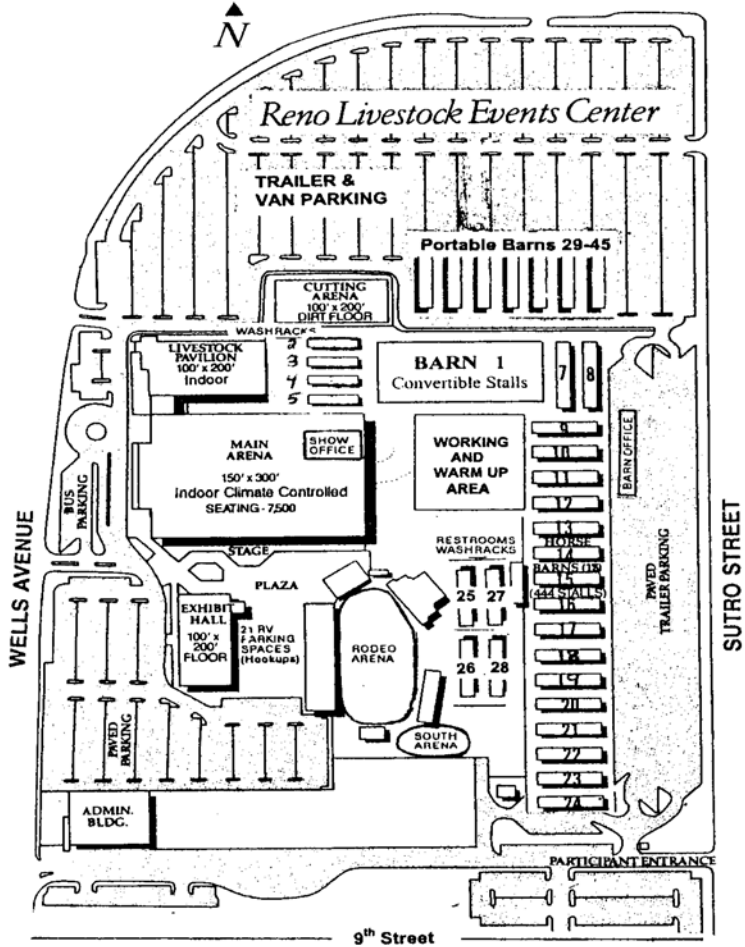
260 CONVERTIBLE STALLS are portable stalls. These stalls are the most convenient and are located closest to the Main Arena, Livestock Pavilion, and Cutting Arena. Stalls are lighted and have convenient electrical outlets and water close by. Aisle ways are dirt.

PORTABLE STALLS – Barns No. 2-5 and 25-30+

There could be approximately 100+ PORTABLE STALLS. 80 portable stalls will be located directly outside the Livestock Pavilion. 20-80 portable stalls will be located between the Rodeo Arena and the Permanent Barns adjacent to the staging area (see map). If additional portable stalls are needed, they will be assembled in the North Parking lot on the asphalt. These stalls have full doors with canvas roofs. Stalls are lighted and water is located close to each barn.

CLEANING OF STALLS

Dumpsters will be spotted at convenient locations to ALL barns. Deposit refuses directly into dumpsters. Do not stack in center valley drain or at end of aisle ways. Exhibitors are asked to clean stalls daily prior to noon. RLEC will pick up all stacked refuse by noon. Late refuse may sit overnight. Your help with this request would be greatly appreciated & help with the overall cleanliness of the grounds. **DO NOT TIE HORSES TO HOSE BIBS OR FENCES.** Please sweep the aisle ways and keep hosing down to a minimum.

****IMPORTANT** - EXHIBITORS WILL BE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY FOR ANY DAMAGE TO STALLS OR OTHER FACILITIES. ABSOLUTELY NO NAILS ARE ALLOWED IN PERMANENT STALLS OR STALL DOORS. DO NOT USE CONTACT CEMENT OR ANY OTHER PERMANENT ADHESIVE TO ATTACH STALL SIGNS OR DRAPES TO BARNs. DO NOT DRIVE OVER RLEC TRAFFIC BUMPERS OR CURBS. DO NOT TIE HORSES TO WATER OR ELECTRICAL PIPES. YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR DAMAGES IF ANY OCCUR.

SHOWING FROM TRAILERS

Exhibitors MAY show from their trailers. The trailer-in fee is **\$25.00 PER HORSE**. Every horse entered in these shows MUST pay a stall fee or grounds/trailer in fee.

TRAILER PARKING AREAS

The NORTH Parking Lot has been designated for parking of horse trailers and vans for exhibitors reserving stalls. Unload and load from the EAST parking lot, WEST FIRE LANE, or other approved areas. **DO NOT** drive vehicles between barns. **DO NOT** drive over curbs. Please move your vehicle to designated parking area in the NORTH LOT as soon as possible. **Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed in the stabling area during the show.** Only the EAST, NORTH and PAVED PARKING area south of the Rodeo Arena will be available for parking & park only in designated parking spaces. Vehicles must not protrude beyond parking lanes & Violators may be towed at their expense. **ANY HORSE TRAILER, VAN or Horse Trailer used for a tack room, parking in the East Lot OR RV PARKING OVERNIGHT in the NORTH OR EAST PARKING Area will be charged a parking fee of \$10.00 per day.** Permits MUST be obtained at the horse show office.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES (Golf Carts, Mopeds, 3- Wheel Vehicles, Mini Bikes)

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule.

REMEMBER -- HORSES ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY

RV/OVERNIGHT PARKING -- WITH HOOKUPS

RV parking spaces are available located near the Exhibit Hall with electricity, water and sewer hookups; and in the North Lot near the Cutting Arena with electricity and water only. These are the **ONLY** areas on the Reno Livestock Events Center grounds that have RV hookups. **Reservations for RV Hookup spaces must be made through RLEC @ (775) 688-5751 only.** Permits will be issued from RLEC upon your arrival and must be displayed in vehicle and visible at all times.

SHOW INFORMATION

RV/OVERNIGHT PARKING -- SELF CONTAINED VEHICLES

Campers, motor homes and recreational vehicles MAY stay overnight in the **EAST Parking Lot** or **North Parking Lot** for the **FEE OF \$10.00 PER NIGHT**. **OVERNIGHT PARKING PERMITS** will be issued at the Horse Show Office and must be visible at all times. US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION STATEMENT - LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS, AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF \$30.00 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION; 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

AHA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS – Copies of ALL trainer's, driver's, rider's and Breeding/Halter handler's and at least ONE Owner's current AHA **Competition** Membership Cards MUST be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. Any owner, trainer, driver, rider, breeding/halter handler who exhibits horses in the show ring or signs the entry form as the responsible person for any individual's horses at the show must be a current **competition** member of A.H.A. at the time of entry and at the time of showing. For the Regular Show classes only, an AHA Single Event Membership Fee of \$35.00 must be paid if not a current competition member of AHA or you do not have a current competition card. Membership Affidavits are no longer available.

REGION III CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW - CURRENT COMPETITION MEMBERSHIP IN AHA IS A REQUIREMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE REGION 3 CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW.

USEF MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS - Copies of every owner's, trainer's, rider's, driver's and breeding/In-hand halter handler's current USEF Membership Cards MUST be included with the horse show entry form at the time of entry. If showing in Amateur classes, the card must have Amateur Certification included. If you do not have a copy of your current USEF membership card, you will have to pay \$30.00 non refundable non member fee. If you are NOT a member of USEF, you MUST pay the appropriate non-member fee. Affidavits are no longer available. USEF Membership for an adult is \$55 (with or without amateur certification). USEF Membership for junior is \$55.00

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION - Every exhibitor who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the USEF. A non-member may compete as an amateur upon payment of the non-member fee (\$30) and a non-member amateur certification fee (\$30) or \$60. USEF membership is \$55 for an adult and may include the amateur certification at no additional charge. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and will not be issued an amateur certification (see USEF GR 809.1).

GENERAL INFORMATION

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD POINTS – This show is recognized by the AHA enabling exhibitors to receive Achievement Award Points in all USEF approved classes.

ADMISSION TO RING - No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. In any class requiring grooms or other assistants to enter the ring, PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED.

AGE OF HORSES - For horse show purposes, any horse shall be considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. A JUNIOR horse is one that is 5 years old and under.

AMATEUR OWNER FAMILY DEFINITION - An Amateur Owner Class is one in which every contestant is an Amateur and the rider, driver or handler is the Owner or an Amateur Member of the owner's family. "Family" includes husband, wife, parent, stepparent, child, brother, stepchild, sister, half-brother and sister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, grandmother, grandfather and in-laws of the same relation as stated. Combined ownership is NOT permitted in Amateur/Owner classes unless all owners are members of the same family. LEASED horses are NOT eligible.

ARABIAN BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES

Allocated Category A Classes are designated by an asterisk (*) located by the AHA Class Number. **Category B Point Classes** are designated by double asterisks (**) located by the AHA Class Number. Category B Point Classes will have payback \$\$\$ at the end of the show year for horses properly nominated. Exhibitors must have paid the \$100.00 nomination fee (a once a year nomination fee) prior to the start of the show for the ABS classes to count towards Breeders Sweepstakes year end awards. Show secretaries can not accept nominations at the show. Contact AHA today to nominate your Breeders Sweepstakes horse into the "POINTS" program for 2011. **ABS designated classes are OPEN to ALL horses** (your horse does not have to be nominated in the Breeders Sweepstakes program to show in those classes). See detail information in this book.

ARENA DIMENSIONS AND FOOTING – Main Arena is 150' X 300'. Livestock Pavilion is 90' X 200'. Rodeo Arena is 325' X 170'. Cutting Arena is 100' X 125'. The footing is a combination of dirt and sand composition.

BREEDING/GELDING IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIPS – Show Champions and Reserve Champions must be at least two years old and are selected as outlined in USEF GR810.5. Arabian, HA/AA Yearling Geldings may compete for Champion Gelding.

CONDITION OF ENTRIES - All entries, except entries in equitation and showmanship classes must be serviceably sound. All entries must be in good condition. Horses with loss of sight in one eye may compete in performance classes only. Horses must wear a long, natural, unbraided mane (with or without clipped bridle path), and a natural, unset, ungingered tail. The exception being that horses shown under Hunter, Jumper, Show Hack or Dressage appointments are permitted to show with a shortened, pulled braided mane and/or tail and cutting horses with a roached mane). The use of glitter on or in the mane, tail, hair or hooves is prohibited. Horses must be shown without artificial appliances. Anything that alters the intended use of equipment as provided for in the description of appointments for a given class is considered to be an artificial appliance. This includes but is not limited to tongue ties and/or mouth ties. Gag bits are prohibited. Action produced by artificial methods shall be penalized. The use of chains, rollers or similar devices on the show grounds during or before a show is prohibited and the show committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show, and they shall forfeit all entry fees and winnings for the entire show.

CRUELTY AND ABUSE - USEF GR839, AR105, AND AHA ARTICLE 304.6 WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AT ALL AHA RECOGNIZED COMPETITIONS.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse, owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, handler or driver from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

DISQUALIFICATION - Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show ring will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made or caused to be made, any false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing, or exhibiting. In case any animal is disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in the class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal and the lowest moneyed prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.

DOGS - Dogs may be brought onto the show grounds, but must be on a leash at all times. Dogs will not be allowed in any building including ARENAS, REST ROOMS and OFFICES. Dog owners MUST clean up after their dogs. Dogs left unattended in the barn area, RV parking area, parking lot, etc. that BARK and/or DISTURB other exhibitors or guests will be asked to be removed from the grounds by Security. Please keep dogs under control at all times and be considerate of others.

ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION DEVICES — Electronic communication devices used for the purpose of coaching, etc. between competitors and individuals outside the ring, shall be prohibited in all classes in the Arabian Division. Exempt from this rule are handicapped riders who have submitted written proof to the USEF Steward.

FARRIER - The show farrier will be available on the show grounds during all scheduled sessions located close to Main Arena. The show farrier will also be available Saturday July 9th approximately 10:00 a.m.

GATE RULE - Due to a full schedule of classes, the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be STRICTLY enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes or rings. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes, at the completion of the final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction.

HALF ARABIAN / ANGLO ARABIAN COLTS/STALLIONS – Half Arabian and Anglo Arabian stallions registered with AHA or which have been issued an AHA (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit are permitted to compete in the AHA performance classes for Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses. Half Arabian colts & stallions, two years & older, are excluded from all Breeding/ In-Hand classes. Half Arabian stallions may compete in Sport horse In Hand Classes for Half Arabian & Anglo-Arabian horses. (Exception: see Article 1699Y.3). Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian colts/stallions may compete in weanling and yearling Breeding/ In-Hand classes for geldings and in Sport Horse In Hand classes.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS - Every horse entered in the show will be assigned an identification number. It is important for the proper handling of the show that the riders, drivers and handlers wear the correct number in all classes.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HEADGEAR – All juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling & exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEA) in any division or class without penalty from the judge.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize list. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Committee or Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES - All entries are accepted with the understanding that REGION III of AHA and the RENO LIVESTOCK EVENT CENTER will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify REGION III of AHA and the RENO LIVESTOCK EVENT CENTER, against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions herein set forth.

JUNIOR EXHIBITORS - To be eligible, riders must not have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year. The age of an individual on December 1st will be maintained throughout the entire competition year. Persons born on December 1st assume the greater age on that date.

MAIDEN, NOVICE AND LIMIT CLASSES - Maiden, Novice & Limit classes are open to horses which have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively, at Regular Member Competitions of USEF or CEF in the particular performance division in which they are shown. For this show, a Maiden, Novice or Limit Horse/Rider is as of the closing date of entries (JUNE 1st)

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

ARABIAN HORSES--Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

HALF ARABIAN / ANGLO ARABIAN HORSES - Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an Arabian Horse Association (Canadian Part-bred Arabian Registrar) CPAR Permit; or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry & registration applied for and be entered under their full registered name

REGISTRATION PAPERS REQUIRED - A copy of the current registration papers showing proof of ownership (**FRONT & BACK** of old papers; **FRONT** of new papers) **MUST** be submitted with the entry form at the time of making an entry. The copies will be returned in your show packet.

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR AMATEUR/OWNER - Horses entered in an Amateur Owner or Junior Owner class **MUST** be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family (as defined by USEF GR122). Horses registered in a farm/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the farm or entity. The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contract or Bill of Sale will **NOT** be accepted.

RULES - This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation, Chapter AR - Arabian, Half-Arabian & Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of USEF will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for the knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted & judged in accordance therewith. The Show Committee shall decide questions that are not addressed by USEF Rules and their decision is final.

SCRATCHING OR CANCELING CLASSES - As a **COURTESY** to the GATEMAN, ANNOUNCER and SHOW OFFICE, exhibitors are **requested** to notify the GATEMAN and SHOW OFFICE when it is necessary to scratch or cancel a class entered. This courtesy will enable the Show to run more efficiently. Your consideration is appreciated!

SELECT AOTR CLASSES – Classes are open to a rider/driver/handler that has NOT won any of the following: 1) AHA Regional Top Five or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective section; 2) AHA National Top Ten or better in the corresponding class or any open class in the respective section; 3) Two AHA Regional Top Five or higher in a corresponding Limited class; 4) AHA National Top Ten or higher award in a corresponding Limited class. Riders of Arabian, Half-Arabian/Anglo Arabian horses competing in the same section shall not be considered separately. If a rider is eligible to compete as a Limited rider in a respective section on December 1, said eligibility remains throughout the competition year (beginning with Regional and National shows 1997).

STALLIONS - Ladies and junior exhibitors in any class in this show except Showmanship, Walk Trot and Lead Line may show Arabian stallions. Unruly horses in any class will be promptly dismissed.

USEF/DRUG FEE – For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation (USEF), a **\$15.00** Federation Fee will be collected per horse (\$7 shall be an Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1,.2 and .3) The exhibitor must file an official Equine Drugs and Medications Report Form (in writing) with the Show Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative within one hour after administration or one hour after the Steward or Designated Competition Office Representative returns to duty if administration is at a time other than during competition hours. The official Drugs and Medication Report Form is available from the officiating Show Steward or Designated Competition Representative.

VETERINARIAN - A veterinarian will be present throughout the show & will be available on the grounds during all scheduled sessions. The Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. No veterinarian other than the official show veterinarian will be permitted to treat, medicate, or attend to a horse on the grounds. Anyone wishing to use another veterinarian other than the official Show Veterinarian on the grounds must obtain permission from Show Management.
