NEW HELMET REQUIREMENTS FOR DRESSAGE EXHIBITORS - The dress code for Training through Fourth Levels is a short riding coat of conservative color, with tie, choker or stock tie, white or light-colored breeches or jodhpurs, boots or jodhpur boots, and protective headgear as defined in DR120.5 and in compliance with GR801. Protective headgear is defined as a riding helmet which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/ SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. The harness must be secured and properly fitted. AR 156 Dressage Classes: When cross entry by rider or horse/rider combination is permitted between Dressage and other Arabian classes at a competition, DR120 and DR121 apply only to the designated Dressage warm-up and competition areas, or when an exhibitor is actually warming-up for Dressage class(es).

- 1) Post Entries will be accepted until June 24. Post entries may not appear in the show Program. U.S. POSTMARK DATE will be used to determine fees (personal or business postage meter marks will not be used).
- 2) ALL CLASSES -All horses qualified prior to close of entries May 31st MUST enter by May 31st. Late entries will be accepted for those horses ONLY that qualify at an open Dressage Show held between June 1 and June 24 or at PCASHC. Entries must be made by 12 noon 6/24.

QUALIFICATIONS RULES -The points/scores listed on the National Class List for Regional classes must be obtained in the same AHA Section listed in the AHA Standard Class List. The Point System as reflected on the National Class List is implemented for all Regional classes commencing with the 2005 show season. The number of points a horse receives is based on the number of horses shown and judged in that class. Horses will earn one point for every horse in the class. Points for qualifications will be awarded to placing first through sixth. All other placing will be recorded, however, will not receive qualification points refer to Points will be calculated as follows: Twelve horses entered - 1st place = 12 points; 2nd place = 11 points; 3rd place = 10 points; etc. One horse entered - 1st place = 1 point. Regional Top Five, Champion or Reserve Champion do not qualify a horse for a Regional Championship class - only points and scores from shows other than Regional or Nationals will count for qualification for Regional Shows.

POINT SYSTEM

ONE point is needed to qualify for the following classes: HA/AA Sport Horse Show Hack; Arabian Sport Horse Show Hack; HA/AA Stallions Sport Horse in Hand

TWO points are needed to qualify for the following classes: HA/AA Mares Sport Horse in Hand; HA/AA Geldings Sport Horse in Hand; Arabian Sport Horse Under Saddle, Junior Horse; HA/AA Sport Horse Under Saddle, Junior Horse, Arabian Sport Horse in Hand, Arabian Sport Horse Under Saddle, HA/AA Sport Horse Under Saddle

TWO points OR 2 Scores are needed to qualify for the following classes: Dressage Training; Dressage First Level; Dressage Second Level; Dressage Third Level

ONE point OR 1 Score is needed to qualify for the following classes: Dressage Fourth Level; Dressage Prix St. Georges; Dressage Intermediate I; Dressage Intermediate II; Dressage Grand Prix; Dressage Walk/Trot

DRESSAGE Qualifying scores may be obtained at an AHA Recognized or USEF/EC/USDF recognized Open shows (the horse must be enrolled in the AHA Dressage Program, refer to AHA Handbook.. Show must be held in the same Region as the Region Championship class entered. Scores earned from Regional Championship classes will not count toward qualifications.

WALK TROT 10 & under - ONE score of 55% or better from the USDF Introductory Dressage Test.

TRAINING LEVEL and FIRST LEVEL - TWO Scores of 58% or better from USEF/CEF judges rated in the Dressage division;

SECOND and THIRD LEVEL - TWO scores of 55% or better from USEF/CEF judges rated in the Dressage division;

FOURTH LEVEL, PRIX ST. GEORGES, INTERMEDIATE I, INTERMEDIATE II and GRAND PRIX - One score of 50% or better from a USEF/CEF judge rated in the Dressage Division.

OPEN SHOW QUALIFICATIONS - For USEF/CEF/USDF Open Shows scores to count toward AHA Regional Championship classes, the horse must be enrolled in the AHA Open Show Program. Report forms for scores must be postmarked/electronic transaction dated within 30 days of the competition.

AMATEUR OWNER QUALIFICATIONS - All horses entering any Regional Amateur Owner (AO, AAO, JO) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur Owner. It is the responsibility of the Amateur Owner to abide by this rule.

AMATEUR QUALIFICATIONS - All horses entering any Regional Amateur (ATR, AATR, JTR) Championship class must have been qualified by an Amateur. It is the responsibility of the Amateur to abide by this rule.
