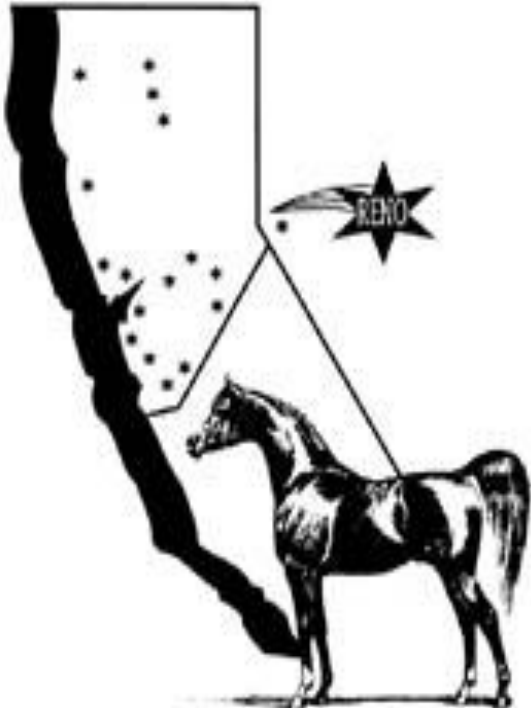

DO NOT MAIL ENTRIES AFTER APRIL 14th. E-mail entries to workingwestern@gmail.com or hand-carry them to the show and enter at the show office by 5:00pm Saturday, May 6th.

ENTRY INFORMATION

The best way to enter the Region III Off-site Cow Horse Championships is by completing the entry form and emailing it to WORKINGWESTERN@gmail.com. If mailing your entries, please **do not mail after April 14th**. There is a lot of information that needs to be entered into the show software program, so we ask that you pre-enter the show. To encourage early entries, show management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to the Show Secretary on or before the entry closing date of May 1, 2023. We appreciate you taking the time to email the entries before May 1, 2023. You may enter or drop classes at the show with no penalty in the show office at time of check-in. Scratches made during the show are not subject to refund. Entries that wait until the day of the show to enter are subject to a \$50 late fee.

SHOW INFORMATION

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES: All entries are accepted with the understanding that Region III of AHA and the ASM Global, RSCVA and their corporate owners, officers, agents, servants, landlord, and employees will not be held responsible from occurrences as to bodily injury liability and property damage liability relating to the event. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify Region III of AHA and the Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center, against any and all loss, damages & liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any & all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions herein set forth.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK & WAIVER FOR RENO-SPARKS LIVESTOCK EVENTS CENTER: All exhibitors entering the Region III Off-site Cow Horse Championships held at Reno-Sparks Livestock Events Center agree to the following: **"I hereby RELEASE and agree to DEFEND INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS ASM GLOBAL, RSCVA their shareholders, officers, employees, agents, instructors, equipment manufacturers, lessors, and the insurers (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties Released"), from and against any liability. Demand, claim, or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE OF ASM GLOBAL or their Parties Released. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against ASM GLOBAL, RSCVA or other Parties Released, for or by reason of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in equestrian activities at RSLEC. I will pay for all fees, damages, and costs, including attorney fees that ASM GLOBAL, RSCVA or other Parties Released may incur in the enforcement of this agreement."**

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles if they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from that operation.** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from the rule.

SHARPS CONTAINERS: Competition management must place a minimum of one (1) sharps container per competition, regardless of whether stabling is provided.

- a. If stabling is provided, for every fifty (50) occupied stalls, one (1) sharps container must be provided for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. These containers must be placed in visible, accessible, and convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.
- b. Sharps Containers: A sharps container is made of puncture-resistant plastic with leak-resistant sides and bottom. It has a tight fitting, puncture resistant lid, which does not allow sharps to come out of the container. Sharps containers must be properly labeled to warn of hazardous waste inside the container. Sharps containers must not be altered in any way from its manufactured form, such as removal of security measures or drilling of the plastic. Sharps containers must be protected from the elements as to not collect rainwater.
- c. It is competition management's responsibility to dispose of contents of sharps containers when the container is three-quarters (3/4) full, in accordance with community guidelines for proper disposal methods. Competition management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100.00 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- d. If local law has more stringent requirements than the above, related to sharps containers or disposal, local law will prevail. Competitions that fail to place the required number of containers on the competition grounds or dispose of the contents properly will be considered in violation of the rules and may be subjected to penalty as determined by the CEO or his designee and/or the Hearing Committee.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded Owner and all Trainers, Drivers, Riders, Halter Handlers, Coaches, and the Person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA, or pay an AHA Single Event Membership Fee per competitor.

When an Agent signs for the Owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the Owner and Agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership.

Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions.

Exhibitors in Walk/Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with Competition Card at AHA Regional and National competitions.

Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or Parents/Guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA Membership requirements (BOD 5/12).

USEF SHOW PASSES- Eligible exhibitors are prohibited from obtaining more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year. BOD 9/26/22 Effective 12/1/22.

Show Passes must be purchased online at USEF.ORG.

REMEMBER- HORSES ALWAYS HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. EACH PARTICIPANT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWLEDGE OF AND IS SUBJECT TO THE USEF RULE BOOK. THE USEF RULE BOOK IS AVAILABLE AT WWW.USEF.ORG. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL DECIDE QUESTIONS NOT COVERED BY USEF RULES AND ITS DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Ride and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions, and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level test, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EC AMATEUR MEMBERS: EC amateur members, competing in amateur classes, must complete and sign a USEF membership application verifying they meet USEF amateur requirements. There is no charge.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: Affidavits are no longer accepted for payment of non-member fees. Exhibitors must have a Competing Membership, either Life, Senior Active or Junior Active Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. See next paragraph.

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION: If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45 (GR1309.2b). Show passes must be purchased online at USEF.org. A Show Pass is only valid for one competition and non-member participants (riders, drivers, vaulters, longeurs, owners, lessees, and agents) are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.

ADDING A CLASS: For horses properly entered in the Regional show prior to entry deadline, there is no penalty to add a class at a later time.

CHANGES, CANCELLATION, OR DIVISION OF CLASSES: Management reserves the right to make changes to arena, judge, or class order to facilitate time schedule and conditions for betterment of the show. All changes will be posted in the Show Office and announced over the public address system.

GATE RULE/GATE HOLDS: When a gate hold is requested, such request will be made to the Paddock Master prior to the start of judging of the class immediately before the class requiring the gate hold. The reason for the gate hold must be stated. The gate-hold will be a maximum of three (3) minutes. Appropriate notice will be given to all exhibitors by way of public address announcement if there is a gate hold in effect. For those classes where the horses show as a group, the two minute gate rule will be in effect. An order of go will be posted for classes that work individually at least one hour prior to the start of the class. Requests for a change in the order of go will be made to the Show Manager. One minute is allowed for an individual work entry to enter the ring. Exhibitors that miss their order of go will be considered a "no show" for the class unless a scratch form has been submitted or the Paddock Master was notified.

RODE DID NOT ENTER (RDNE): An entry that shows in a class in which it was not properly entered will be charged the regular class fee plus a \$25 RDNE fee. To be properly entered in a class, the class must have been listed on the original entry blank or on a properly submitted Add/Scratch Form in the Show Office. Telling the paddock master to add an entry to a class does not constitute a proper entry and will result in an RDNE fee.

ORDER OF GO: All classes with individual work will have an order of go posted at the Show Office. Requests for changes to the order of go are made to the Show Manager. One minute is allowed for an individual work entry to enter the ring. Exhibitors that miss their order of go will be considered a "no show" for the class unless a scratch form has been submitted or the Paddock Master was notified.

RV/OVERNIGHT CAMPING & PARKING: Reservations for RV camping and overnight parking are made directly to Reno-Sparks Livestock Event Center (RSLEC) at (775) 688-5752. There are 67 full hookups with water, electricity & sewer for \$55 per night. There are 22 partial hook-ups with water and electricity for \$45 per night. Permits are issued from RSLEC and must be displayed in vehicle. A free dump station is located at the South End of the East lot by Gate #5. Absolutely no dumping of gray or brown water is allowed anywhere on RSLEC grounds except at designated pedestals or the dump station.

REFUNDS OR CANCELLATIONS OF ENTRIES: To encourage early entries, Show Management agrees to cancel and refund entry and stall fees on any horse not fit to show providing written notice is given to Show Secretary before closing date of May 1, 2023. Horses may be scratched from the show at the owner's option. Refunds of entry fees will be considered for any horse suffering from illness or injury upon the presentation of a veterinarian's certificate accompanied with a letter explaining the circumstances to the Show Manager PRIOR to

the start of Show on May 4th. No refunds will be made on office fees. Refunds on stalls/tack will not be made after May 4, 2023.

ASSIGNMENT OF STALLS: Stalls will be assigned to horses entered and all others will be considered tack or groom stalls. Stalls will be available beginning 8:00am, Thursday, May 4th and must be vacated by Sunday, May 7th unless prior arrangements have been made with Show Manager. Each horse must be assigned a separate stall. **Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must each make note of request on their entry forms.** There is no guarantee of stabling preference. Assignment of stalls will be made based on patronship, time of submission, and number of stalls requested.

STALL INFORMATION: There are 656 permanent 10 x 12 metal stalls available on the grounds. The stalls have full door and stall mats. Electric outlets and water outlets are located at convenient locations in each aisle. Aisle ways are asphalt.

RSLEC NOTICE- Exhibitors may be charged for any damage to the stalls or other facilities. Absolutely NO nails are allowed in permanent stalls or stall doors. Do not use any permanent adhesive to attach stall signs or drapes to the barns. Do not tie horses to water or electrical pipes. Any exhibitor found in violation will be charged accordingly for repair.

SHAVINGS: Bedding must be ordered on the entry form. No outside shavings or straw is allowed on the show grounds. Cost is \$10/bale and will be delivered to your stalls.

VETERINARIAN: A licensed veterinarian from Comstock Equine Hospital will be ON CALL from 7am to 5pm Sunday, May 7th. The telephone number will be posted in the show office and in the barn. It is (775) 849-0120. All animals are subject to physical inspection by the show veterinarian at the discretion of the Show Committee. Show Management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease.

SCORE SHEETS: All score sheets will be available for inspection at the Show Office within one hour from end of class. All score sheets will be mathematically verified before being released.

SHOWING FROM TRAILERS: Exhibitors may show from their trailers and must park in designated parking areas. A grounds fee of \$50 will be charged. Absolutely no vehicles will be allowed in the barn aisles, including the side or front of the barns during the show. RSLEC will enforce this rule throughout the show.

ARRIVAL: Horses may arrive beginning Thursday, May 4th at 8:00am.

ARENA: Classes for the Region III Off-site Cow Horse Championships will be held in the Cutting Arena on the RSLEC show grounds. Footing is comprised of a mixture of native soil and sane.

Class 503: Any Breed: Opportunity- Boxing Only

Exhibitors in the Boxing Only class may be any horse/rider combination entered properly in the Region III Off-site Cow Horse Championship Show. Horses, regardless of age, may be ridden with one hand in a standard western bit or with one or two hands in a snaffle bit or hackamore. Exhibitors are allotted 50 seconds to complete the work. Rider shall enter into the arena, face the cattle entry gate, and signal for their cow to be turned into the arena. The cow shall be controlled on the cow entry end of the arena to demonstrate the horse's ability to hold the cow. Judging procedures follow those described in the AQHA Handbook for VRH Rookie Ranch Cow Work. Exhibitors may use the Boxing Only class as a warm-up or practice class.

Class 504: Any Breed: Opportunity- Box-Drive-Box-Drive

Exhibitors in the Box-Drive-Box-Drive class may be any horse/rider combination entered properly in the Region III Off-site Cow Horse Championship Show. Riders are allotted one minute and forty-five seconds to complete the work. There are four parts to the work: Boxing the cow on cow entry end of the arena, setting up the cow and driving it down the fence to the opposite end of the arena; boxing the cow at the opposite end of the arena, and then driving the cow back down the fence on the original side past the middle marker again. There is no expectation that the exhibitor will make a fence-turn. Judging procedures follow those described in the AQHA Handbook for VRH Limited Ranch Cow Work. Exhibitors may use the Box-Drive-Box-Drive class as a warm-up or practice class.

AWARDS: A full Top 5 "will be made regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA Horse Achievement Award, Amateur Achievement Awards, High Point Horse Achievement Award, High Point Amateur Achievement Award, and Distance Award Points." The Champion in each class will receive a tri-colored championship ribbon with choice of award. Reserve Champion in each class will receive a tri-colored reserve championship ribbon with choice of award. Three Top 5 awards are also available in each class.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

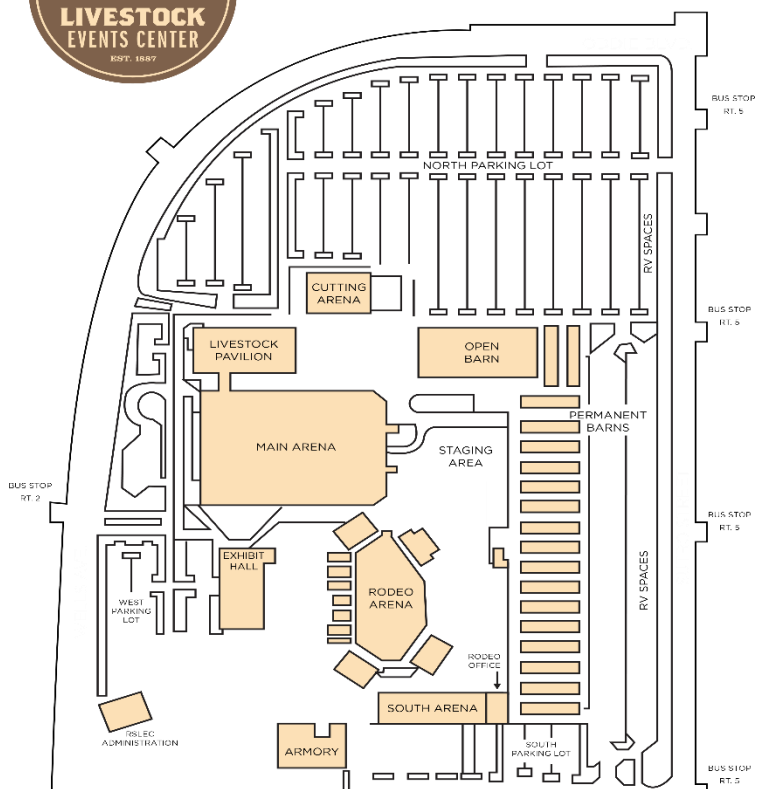

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
